STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS (SCCS) STUDENT ORGANIZATION CONDUCT PROCESS

When a student organization faces an alleged violation, the below process is followed.



INVESTIGATION LENGTH MAY VARY DEPENDING ON ALLEGED VIOLATION TYPE.

WRITTEN NOTICE OF EDUCATIONAL CONFERENCE (page 10)

WRITTEN NOTICE PROVIDED TO THE ORGANIZATION'S STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE BY SCCS AND WILL INCLUDE:

1. Notice that SCCS has begun/will begin investigation

2. Brief description of conduct and the Standard(s) of Conduct at issue

3. Notice of right to an advisor

4. Date/time/location of the Educational Conference

5. Consequences of failing to comply and notice of hold

6. Link to the Student Code of Conduct/Policy

EDUCATIONAL CONFERENCE (page 10)


AN EDUCATIONAL CONFERENCE IS A MEETING BETWEEN SCCS, THE ORGANIZATION'S STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE, AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE LIAISON WHERE THE FOLLOWING GENERALLY OCCURS: 1. SCCS orally informs the organization's Student Representative of the allegations. 2. The organization's Student Representative has an opportunity to respond to allegations and

2. The organization's Student Representative has an opportunity to respond to allegations and present information and witnesses.

3. Both SCCS and the organization's Student Representative may ask questions and seek clarifying information.
4. SCCS may issue a no-action determination or continue investigation.
