

Stalking Incident Log & UT Resources

If you are the victim of stalking, it can be critical to maintain a log of stalking related incidents and behavior, especially if you choose to engage in the university process, and the criminal or civil justice systems. Recording this information will help document the behavior for order of protection applications, university investigations, or criminal prosecution. It may also add to preserve your memory of individual incidents which you may later have to report or testify on.

The stalking log should be used to record and document all stalking related behavior- including harassing phone calls, or call attempts, text messages, letters, internet communications, acts of vandalism, and threats communicated through third parties.

Keep the log in a safe place and tell only someone you trust where you keep your log.

Documenting stalking behavior can be a difficult and emotionally exhausting task. There are numerous campus resources available to help navigate your options.
