
STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS (SCCS)

TITLE IX HEARING

The only available hearing option for Title IX Prohibited Conduct cases is a university-facilitated Title IX Hearing.

NOTICE OF HEARING

A Notice of Hearing will be sent to the Respondent and the Complainant at least ten (10) business days in advance of the hearing date.



PRE-HEARING MEETING/CONFERENCE

The Title IX Hearing Officer may conduct pre-hearing meetings or conferences with the parties (and Advisors).



PRE-HEARING NOTICE OF ADVISOR

Each party will notify the Title IX Hearing Officer of the identity of the party's Advisor at least five (5) business days before the hearing. The University will provide an Advisor if a party does not have one.



HEARING



HEARING DECISION

A Title IX Hearing Officer Notice of Decision will be transmitted to SCCS within fifteen (15) business days of the hearing. SCCS will simultaneously distribute the decision to the parties.
